

MORTE-HOE.

THE death of Mr. James Conibear removes from Morte-Hoe one who has for a great number of years been looked upon as one of the public characters of the parish. In his early years he joined the merchant service, and as an able seaman saw life in various parts of the world, including the Black Sea during the Crimean War. After leaving the sea he acted as rural postman until about twelve months since, when illness compelled him to retire from the service. He was the agent in this parish for the *North Devon Journal*. For a great many years he was caretaker and Poor steward of the Wesleyan Chapel, while he was a local preacher for over thirty years. The interment will take place on Friday next at 3 30 in the cemetery at Morte-Hoe, after a service in the Wesleyan Chapel.
